### **What does Laser Genesis do?**

Laser Genesis is a non-ablative procedure that can reduce visible facial vessels as well as diffuse redness by gently warming the upper dermis, improving the appearance of your skin. The result is a healthy looking and vibrant appearance.

### **The Laser Genesis Difference:**

The Laser Genesis procedure utilizes laser technology that can safely, discretely, and effectively treat small areas like fine and undesirable facial vessels or vessels that cause diffused redness. Unlike many other treatment methods, Laser Genesis is a comfortable, non-ablative form of skin therapy. This means you will be able to see subtle yet consistent results after each treatment, without the unwanted side effects such as bruising or excessive skin irritation. Your therapy can be performed in a relaxed, comfortable manner without the use of general or local anesthesia, gel, or cream.

### **What areas can be treated?**

Unlike many other procedures available today, with Laser Genesis skin therapy, Spa 360 staff can safely treat your entire neck and facial area and most any other area if desired.

### **What are facial vessels or telangiectasia?**

Telangiectasia or facial vessels are dilated capillaries that commonly appear on the surface of the face and in areas around the nose, cheeks, and above the neckline. Capillaries are tiny blood vessels that are present throughout the body. Prolonged sun exposure, aging, trauma, and other factors can cause capillaries to become dilated and visible. There is also a hereditary factor in developing facial telangiectasia. Laser Genesis skin therapy will help your appearance by treating any visible trace of these unsightly veins.

### **What is diffuse redness?**

Diffuse redness is a general appearance of facial redness, such as rosy cheeks. As with facial telangiectasia, this condition is a result of dilated capillaries, however the appearance is more of general redness rather than discrete, well-defined vessels. The most commonly affected areas are the nose, forehead, and cheeks. Diffuse redness is often associated with a condition called rosacea and it can be hereditary. Laser Genesis skin therapy will help your appearance by gently treating and reducing this condition.

### **What can I expect before the treatment?**

There are no complicated pretreatment rituals with this procedure. Prior to the actual Laser Genesis skin treatment you will have your skin cleansed thoroughly, and in some cases, you may be asked to shave the area to be treated so as not to interfere with the laser treatment. Spa 360 staff will review and assist with all pretreatment requirements.

### **How many treatments do I need?**

The treatment results are often very subtle. On average you may require 4 to 6 treatments in order to achieve the results you are looking for. Every patient's conditions and needs may vary. For more information about your expected results or the number of treatments necessary, consult Spa 360 Staff.

### **Is the treatment painful?**

No. Laser Genesis is a comfortable, non-ablative, non-invasive treatment. Unlike other laser treatments it does not wound the skin's surface therefore virtually eliminating the need for complicated post treatment care. Typically patients describe the treatment as a gentle warming of the surface. The treatment does not require any anesthetics, creams, or gels.

### **What results to expect after the treatment?**

Immediately after the treatment you will experience some minor redness. The redness typically lasts only a few hours. Patients often describe the treatment as relaxing and therapeutic with visible results that are subtle yet noticeable. You can expect to immediately return to normal activities utilizing sunscreen if participating in outdoor activities.

### **What are the possible side effects?**

Although most patients report few if any side effects, the most commonly notices might be a slight redness that disappears within a few hours after the treatment. Consult with Spa 360 staff for complete information on the benefits and risks of treatment.



## Post-Treatment Care for Laser Genesis

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Do not use retinoid products (Retin-A-, Renova, Retinol), Alpha Hydroxy Acid, or any other exfoliating products during the first three days after each treatment. You may resume your normal skin care regimen on the fourth day.

Use a mild cleanser and moisturizer during the first three days after the treatment. We recommend the SkinCeuticals line of products for this period.

Always use a broad spectrum sun block or sunscreen of at least SPF 30 every day.

NO exposure of treated areas to sun light or tanning beds for at least 48 hours post treatment.

NO waxing of treated areas within 7 days prior or post Laser Genesis.
